City launches Youth Diversion Program to support local families

The City of Sanger is taking a proactive approach to helping local youth stay on the right path by implementing a Youth Diversion Program through the Sanger Municipal Court. This initiative provides young people with a second chance while ensuring accountability in a constructive manner.

As part of a statewide mandate, all municipal and justice courts in Texas are required to establish a Youth Diversion Plan by January 1, 2025. Sanger's program's primary goal is to steer youth away from the traditional court system and into programs focused on education, community service, and personal growth.

A New Path for Sanger's Youth

The Youth Diversion Program offers an alternative to fines and criminal records for minors who make mistakes. If a young person between the ages of



10 and 16 is charged with a non-traffic-related minor offense—such as vandalism, theft, or disorderly conduct—they may qualify for diversion instead of a conviction. The Sanger Municipal Court will notify eligible families.

Rather than facing long-term legal consequences, participating youth may be required to:

- Complete community service
- Attend educational programs or counseling
- Write letters of apology or reflection
- Pay restitution, if necessary

Balancing Accountability with Opportunity

This program provides young individuals with the

opportunity to learn from their mistakes without carrying the burden of a permanent record. However, accountability remains a key component—participants must fulfill all program requirements to have their case dismissed.

Building a Brighter Future for Sanger

Prior to this initiative, local youth had limited options once they entered the municipal court system. Now, Sanger has a structured approach to early intervention, supporting families while promoting positive outcomes for young residents.

“This program is about guiding kids toward better choices while ensuring they take responsibility for their actions,” said Kylie Hackworth, Youth Diversion Coordinator for the City of Sanger. “By providing the right support, we can help them move forward without being permanently impacted by a minor mistake.”

George Washington Franklin

August 25, 1926 - April 9, 2025

George Washington Franklin, 98, of Sanger, Texas, passed away April 9, 2025. He was born on August 25, 1926, at his parents' home on Alabama Street in Dallas, Texas. His parents, Robert Lee and Lovelee Franklin, welcomed him into a world that would soon challenge him greatly.

George's childhood was marked by the hardships of the Great Depression. At the tender age of six, he lost his father, Robert Lee Franklin, which placed an immense burden on his mother, older brother, Jack and himself. The couple found joy in gardening and cherished family time, passionately supporting their children's and grandchildren's sports endeavors. Together, they owned and managed several grocery stores, combining Maxine's charismatic personality with George's diligent work ethic.

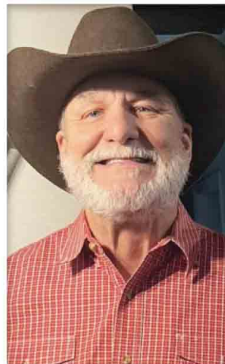

The Cross on the Hill

Since the early 1950's, the parishioners and friends of Blue Mound United Methodist Church have flocked to the cross atop a hill between Sanger and Denton while Easter morning is still dark.

Nothing symbolized their faith more than that cross, located on the Kay Trietsch farm just off Cowling Road and down Henry Lane. That cross meant even more to the youth group who built it about 75 years ago. Shirley Trietsch Haisler is the only member left of that MYF group of cross builders still attending Blue Mound UMC.

The cross is visible from I-35 near the Milam Road exit. The words "Christ Arose" are formed with white rocks on the hillside.

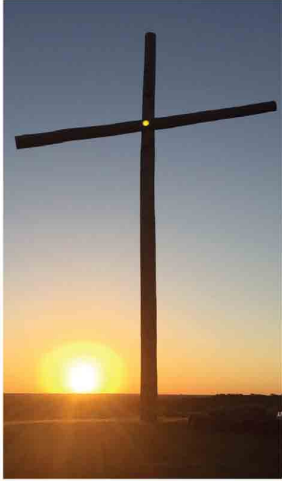
The original cross and words were built over a course of several weeks, gathering truckloads of rocks for the formation of the words. Over time, the

rocks have been repainted several times, and the cross, after being struck by lightning and damaged by the elements, has been replaced several times.

The view from the hill reveals the countryside and overlooks a pond which is particularly beautiful when the sun rises and lifts the fog from the pond below.

Temperatures on the hill through the years have often been quite chilly in the early hours of Easter mornings. Attendees bring quilts to sit on (or to wrap in), coats to keep warm & lawn chairs if sitting is preferred or necessary. On years with rain on Easter morning, the service is moved into the home of Kay Trietsch.

This year attendees will gather at 6:30 a.m. for a time of quiet fellowship, music and a message from Oliver Davidson, a Deacon at Denton First Baptist Church but be sure to dress warmly! Afterwards,



wards, everyone is invited for breakfast in the home of Kay Trietsch, another long-time tradition.

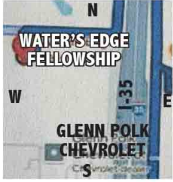
