Man shot and killed by Denton County Sheriff's deputy

A Denton County Sheriff's deputy shot and killed a man Monday evening northwest of Sanger. The sheriff's office did not identify the man who was killed. He was taken to Medical City Denton, where he was pronounced dead sometime Monday night, the spokesman said without specifying a time of death. Spokesman Orlando Hinojosa said the man was wanted on multiple felony warrants from Florida. The Sanger News has learned Kris Adams, 37 was the man shot and killed. He is the son of Kristin Adams, from Sanger and nephew to Julie Adams, from Sanger. The photo to the right was on Kris' facebook page. Kris Adams was born January 5, 1982. Deputies were trying to arrest Adams at about 5:45 p.m. in the 4300 block of View Road near Sanger when he allegedly fled a residence, and he was later shot and killed when he allegedly "displayed" a handgun to the deputies pursuing him, according to a Denton County Sheriff's Office spokesman. The Sheriff's Department said the wanted suspect jumped through a window and deputies ran after the suspect. Deputies ordered the suspect to drop the weapon and he refused to. A Denton County Warrant Deputy fired his gun striking and killing the suspect. Authorities did not release the name of the deputy who shot and killed the man.

Indians offense comes alive against Bridgeport

The Sanger Indians varsity football team had 500 yards of offense and 24 first downs against Bridgeport on Friday. The Bulls led 14-0 when the Indians scored two touchdowns. Sanger quarterback Rylan Smart scored on 6-yard run and a 34-yard run. The Indians scored in the second quarter on a spectacular play when Tallyn Welborn caught a pass up the middle and dashed to the endzone on a 79-yard score. He broke several tackles along the way. Creed Carter caught the 2-point conversion from Smart to tie the game at 21-21 at halftime.

The Bulls scored 21 straight points in the third quarter on plays of 57, 6 and 39 yards. Smart ran for a 54 yard score in the fourth quarter to pull within 14 points, but Bridgeport added two more touchdowns on a 60 yard run and six yard score.

Sanger had two touchdowns called back in the first half. A throwback pass to Smart was called back for holding. He sprinted 75 yards down the right sideline for the score. And Smart threw up a long pass down the middle that Zach Shepard jumped up and made a great catch, but was called for offensive pass interference for a pushoff. Shepard ended up with six catches for 72 yards.

Smart was 13-26 for 183 yards and one touchdown. He had three interceptions on 50-50 balls.

Jacob Pritchett and Welborn were

bright spots at running back. Pritchett had 11 carries for 98 yards and Welborn 18-69 ran over people up the gut. Smart ended up with 146 yards on 23 runs. Ben Turnbow caught four passes for 23 yards.

Sanger takes on Mineral Wells for homecoming. Mineral Wells was off last week. They lost to no. 7 ranked Graham 56-0 in week one and lost to Carrollton Ranhview two weeks ago 21-14. The Indians are still looking for their first win of the season.

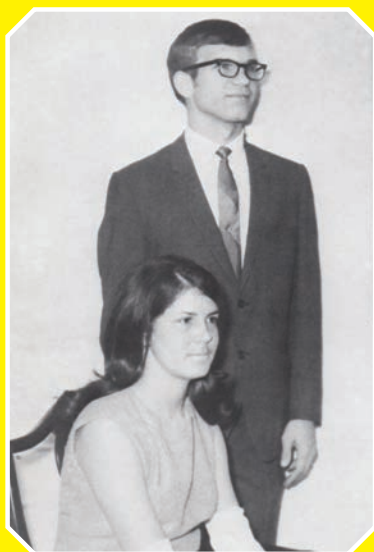
