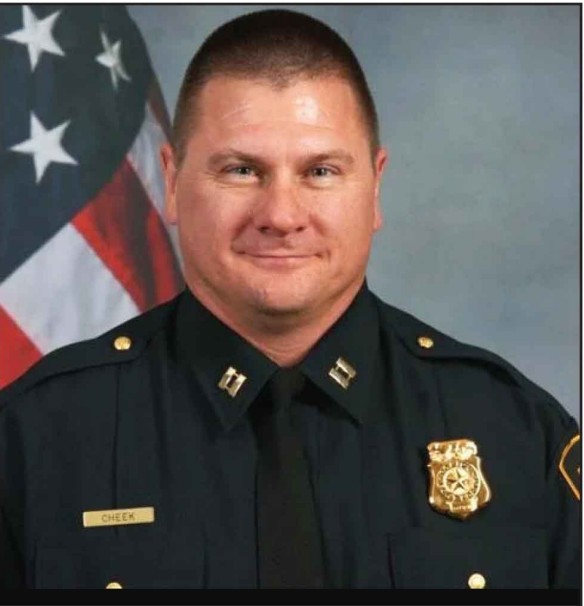

City hires interim Police Chief

After its last police chief left without notice amidst controversy, the city of Sanger announced a new interim chief, a longtime law enforcement officer from Fort Worth, during its City Council meeting Monday.

Tyson Cheek, of Millsap in Parker County, served his first day as the Sanger Police Department's interim chief on Monday. Cheek was present at the council meeting and spoke with the Denton Record-Chronicle about his plans for his tenure.

Cheek's announcement follows the sudden departure of former Chief

Waylan Rhodes on May 12 and the indictment of a former Sanger officer on charges related to excessive use of force. That former officer also made allegations against the chief for sexual misconduct.

While he said he was "just an interim," Cheek said he is aware of recent events at the Police Department and feels hopeful about what he can accomplish while he acts as interim.

Given the former officer's indictment and the other allegations, Cheek told the Record-Chronicle he intends to read person-

nel files to see if there are any causes for concern among current staff.

Cheek said he's already had conversations with officers about the history of the department, their concerns and what the future of the department could look like.

Cheek was recommended to city staff as a candidate for interim chief by a mutual connection, he said.

With almost 32 years of experience in law enforcement, Cheek has held several different ranks. Since 2013, he served as a captain in Fort Worth with noted skills in community policing, investigations, training and crime prevention, among others, according to his LinkedIn profile.

Cheek holds a bachelor's degree from Tarleton State University in criminal justice and political science.

City Manager John Noblitt said the city is very excited to have Cheek help assess where the Police Department is at and where it's headed.

Noblitt said that Cheek will be sworn in Tuesday but his ceremonial swearing-in will be scheduled for a future City Council meeting agenda.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Sanger, Texas (the City) will hold a meeting at its regular meeting place at the Historic Church Building, 403 N. 7th Street, Sanger, Texas at 7:00 p.m. on the 17th day of July, 2023, which is the time and place tentatively set for the passage of an ordinance and such other action as may be deemed necessary to authorize the issuance of the City's certificates of obligation in two series (Series 2023B and Taxable Series 2023C), payable from an annual ad valorem taxation, as well as a limited (in an amount not to exceed \$1,000) pledge of certain revenues of the water and sewer system, in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$6,000,000 for Series 2023B and \$11,000,000 for Series 2023C, bearing interest at any rate or rates not to exceed the maximum interest rate now or hereafter authorized by law, as shall be determined within the discretion of the City Council at the time of issuance and maturing over a period of years not to exceed forty (40) years from the date thereof, for the purpose of evidencing the indebtedness of the City (1) to finance the purchase of approximately 450 acres of land situated northeast of Rector Road and southeast of the City, (2) to finance water, wastewater, and electric system improvements, and (3) to pay for professional services pursuant to Subchapter C of Chapter 271, Texas Local Government Code, as amended. The estimated combined principal and interest required to pay the Certificates on time and in full is \$11,429,390 for Series 2023B and \$24,354,053 for Series 2023C. Such estimate is provided for illustrative purposes only and is based on an assumed interest rate of 4.25% for Series 2023B and 6.00% for Series 2023C. Market conditions affecting interest rates vary based on a number of factors beyond the control of the City, and the City cannot and does not guarantee a particular interest rate associated with the Certificates. As of the date of this Notice, the aggregate principal amount of public securities of the City secured by and payable from ad valorem taxes (excluding public securities secured by an ad valorem tax but designated by the City as self-supporting) is \$34,997,400 and based on the City's expectations, as of the date of this Notice the combined principal and interest required to pay all of the outstanding tax-supported debt obligations of the City secured by and payable from ad valorem taxes (excluding public securities secured by an ad valorem tax but designated by the City as self-supporting) on time and in full is \$7,493,317.

Should you consider 401(k) loans or withdrawals?

At some point, you may have more money in your 401(k) than in any other investment. And even though your 401(k) is intended for your retirement, you may one day think you have to tap into your account early — but should you? And if you do, how should you go about it?

If it's possible to avoid taking money from your 401(k) before you retire, you probably should do

so. You could spend 25 or more years in retirement, and you'll need to pay for those years, so you may want to look for alternatives to your 401(k). If you've built an emergency fund containing several months' worth of living expenses in cash or cash equivalents, you could use some of this money. If you have a Health Savings Account (HSA), you could use it to pay for qualified medical expenses. Or you could sell some of your taxable investments, rather than going into your tax-deferred 401(k).

But if you have determined that you must look at your 401(k) plan to meet a short-term funding need, you'll want to carefully consider how to go about it. You typically have two main choices: loans or withdrawals.

For plans that allow

loans, employees can generally borrow up to 50% of the vested amount of their 401(k)s, up to a maximum of \$50,000 within a 12-month period. Administrative fees may apply, and Interest will be charged, but it will be added back to the 401(k) account as part of the loan repayments. Except when they're used for a home purchase, loans must be repaid within five years, with equal payments made at least quarterly, unless payments are allowed to be paused temporarily. If you leave the company or don't repay the loan according to the agreement, the loan balance will likely be treated as a taxable distribution.

Now, let's consider withdrawals. For 401(k) plans that allow current employees to make withdrawals, the withdrawal requests are usually considered either hardship or non-hardship. To qualify for a hardship withdrawal, you must demonstrate an immediate and heavy financial need to pay for certain expenses, including a home purchase, college, a medical issue or other specified costs, and your withdrawal is limited to the amount necessary to meet the need. Non-hard-

ship withdrawals can typically be taken for any purpose but usually are not granted until you're 59½ or older.

Unlike with a loan, a hardship withdrawal can't be repaid, while a non-hardship withdrawal can usually only be repaid by rolling over the amount to an IRA within 60 days. But the bigger issue may be taxes. If you withdraw funds from your 401(k), any previously untaxed money is generally taxed as ordinary income and a 10% penalty will apply if you're younger than 59½, unless you qualify for an exception. Plus, your 401(k) plan typically must withhold 20% of the withdrawal for taxes, so you'd have to take an even larger withdrawal to meet your needs.

Before embarking on a 401(k) loan or withdrawal, you may want to consult with a financial professional and your tax advisor. Taking money from your 401(k) is a big move, so make sure you know everything that's involved.
