City of Sanger changes the utility billing cycles

To increase efficiencies as the city grows, the City of Sanger is adding a second utility billing cycle. Accounts in the City located on the east side of the railroad tracks are billed in a separate billing cycle, which started in March.

Accounts east of the railroad:

- Utility Bills will be mailed on the 5th of each month
- Late Fees will apply for bills outstanding on the 20th of each month
- Depending on the service address,

some accounts will have a new account number

- Accounts set up for Automated Bank Draft will draft on the 19th of each month

If your account number has changed, you will need to register your new account number in your online account. Doing so will allow you to view details of the account and make online payments.

Sanger fire department responds to deadly house fire, funeral services held for Kristopher Marple

A joint investigation into a fatal weekend house fire is underway, officials said Monday, March 9.

Valley View Police Chief Scott Otto said he believes 37-year-old Kristopher Marple died in the early Saturday, March 7, blaze. Otto said he is awaiting Marple's autopsy.

Firefighters responded to the single-family house fire at 115 Gibson Lane around 1:30 a.m., Cooke County Fire Marshal Ray Fletcher said.

Fletcher said a family of four lived at the house. The "mother and father" were the only ones home at the time of the blaze and the "father didn't make it out."

The family had two girls, ages 5 and 7, Otto said. The girls were staying with grandparents at the time of the fire.

Fletcher said there were no other reports of injuries to occupants or first responders that he knew of. However, one dog was also lost in the fire, he said.

The house is a "total loss," Fletcher said.

Otto said the home was a rental and he was unsure if the family had rental insurance.

Gainesville Fire-Rescue as well as Valley View, Era, North Shore and Sanger volunteer fire departments responded to the call, Fletcher said. Personnel with Cooke County Emergency Medical Services, the Cooke County Fire Marshal's Office and the Valley View Police Department also went out to the reported fire.

A rosary with visitation was held the evening of Tuesday, March 10, 2020 at Slay Memorial Chapel in Aubrey. A Mass of Christian Burial was held at 10:00AM, Wednesday, March 11, 2020 at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church in Pilot Point.



How Much Will Market Volatility Really Affect You?

There's no way to sugarcoat it: If you're an investor, you haven't liked what you've seen in the financial markets recently. The effects of the coronavirus triggered a market "correction" – a decline of

10 percent or more – and more volatility is almost certainly on the way. But instead of fretting over your investment statements, you could consider some more positive approaches to this situation.

For one thing, ask yourself this: When do you really need the money from your investment accounts, such as your IRA and your 401(k) or similar employer-sponsored plan? These are retirement accounts, so, depending on your age, you may not need to tap into them for 20, 30 or even 40 years. If so, your losses may be "paper" ones only for now and aren't subjecting you to imminent financial jeopardy. This isn't to minimize the effect this downturn will have on you, of course – it always takes time to recover lost ground, and there are no guarantees with investing. However, although past performance does not guarantee future results, it is useful to note that, over its long history, the U.S. stock market has typically trended in one direction – up – despite serious and sometimes lengthy declines such as we saw in the Great Depression and, to a lesser extent, the bursting of the "dot.com" bubble of the early 2000s and the financial crisis of 2008-09.

Nonetheless, you may have shorter-term goals – a wedding, down payment on a home, overseas trip, etc. – for which you need to save.

For these goals, though, you wouldn't want to touch your IRA or 401(k), anyway, as you'd likely face taxes and penalties. Instead, you'll want your money invested in liquid, low-risk accounts that will be minimally affected, if at all, by declines in the financial markets. These vehicles might include Certificates of Deposit (CDs), money market accounts and even good old-fashioned U.S. Savings Bonds, all of which offer the protection of principal and can pay higher rates than traditional bank savings accounts.

But you might also have longer-term goals that can be addressed through investments that may be somewhat or largely free of the effects of market volatility. For example, to supplement your retirement income, you might consider a fixed annuity, which can provide you with a guaranteed interest rate and, depending on how it's structured, an income stream you can't outlive.

Apart from the issue of when you might need money from your investment accounts, you might want to ask yourself another question: Just how much of my net worth is tied up in my portfolio? If you're like many people, you have other assets apart from your investments. If you're a homeowner, consider your house: Has it dropped in value at all during the recent market decline? Probably not. Do you still have just as much equity in it as you did a month ago? You might have even more. In other words, the value of your investments may have dropped a certain percentage, but the decline in your overall net worth may well be significantly smaller.

So, here's the bottom line: Large drops in the financial markets aren't much fun for investors – but that doesn't mean the bottom has dropped out on your financial future. Keeping things in perspective is a good move in all of life's endeavors – including investing.

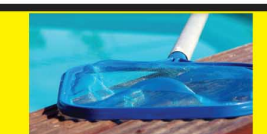

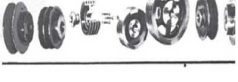

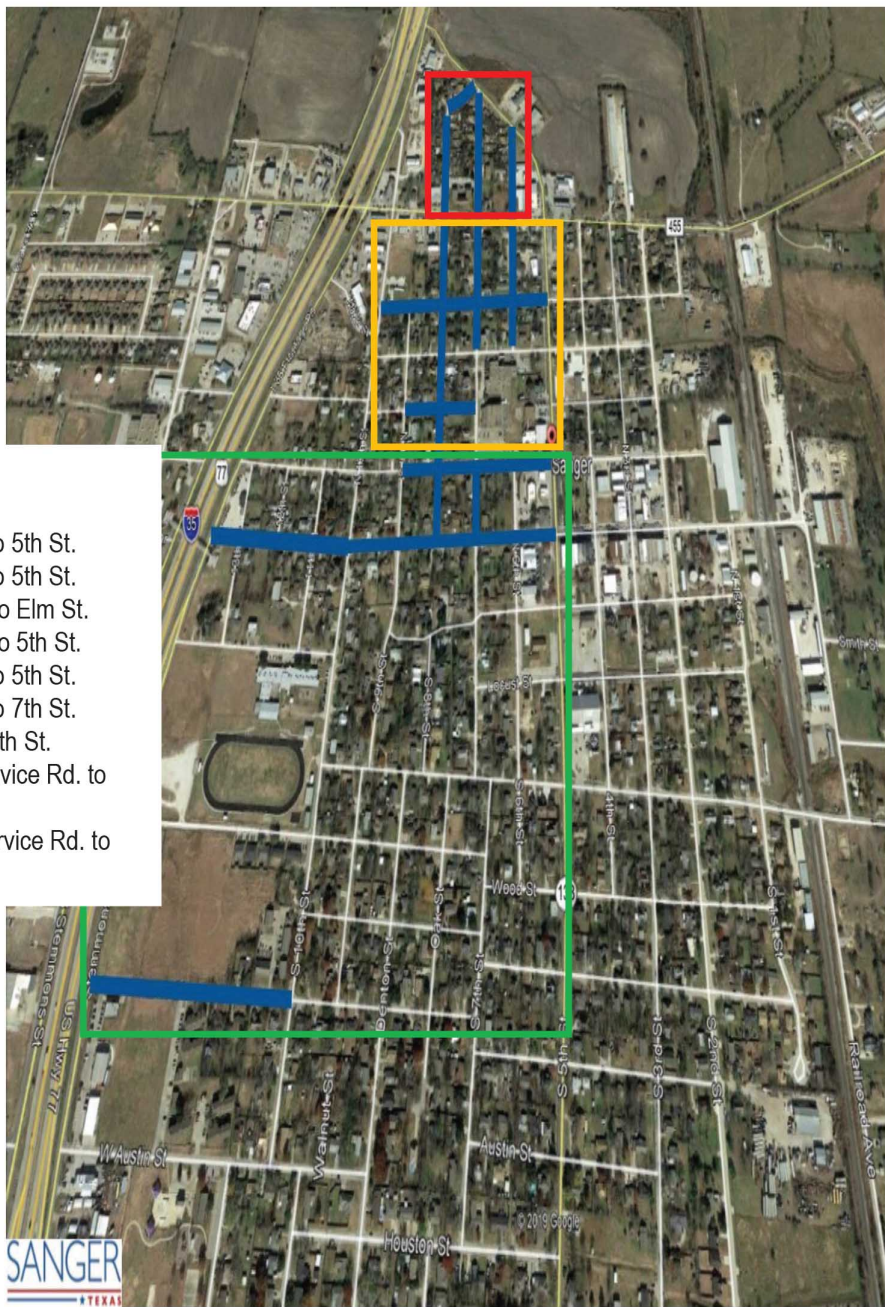
