"Aquatic vegetation has increased somewhat since the last Classic in 2021," said Bennett. "That's due to natural causes with the stability of the lake level and rainfall supporting vegetation growth.

Ray Roberts is divided into two arms that run north and south on the compass dial. Those are the Elm Fork of the Trin-

As a Corps of Engineers Lake, there has been minimal development around the 259 miles of shoreline, so most of the shoreline is natural and consists of rocky banks and seasonally flooded shrubs like button bush.


Ray Roberts is on a regular stocking program to keep the fishery up to par with other trophy lakes in Texas. The lake has received 4.6 million

Florida largemouth, with the fisheries management plan calling for subsequent stockings every two to three years. Notably in 2024, 347,000 Lonestar Bass were stocked, which are descendants of ShareLuker Legacy class largemouth weighing 13 pounds or more.

Will the Classic fishery show out with a double-digit trophy? There is a legit chance it will happen. After all, Texas is known as the land of the giants.

to Fort Worth for fishing's biggest event of the year. Dubbed the Super Bowl of Bass Fishing, this tournament is estimated to draw crowds approaching 150,000 to Fort Worth as anglers compete for a \$1 million dollar purse on March 21-23, 2025.

Anglers will launch their boats at Isle Du Boise State Park just east of Sanger at Ray Roberts Lake. wake of the COVID-19 pandemic the last time we visit-Weigh-ins will be held at Dickies Arena.

The Fort Worth Sports Commission will host the tournament and festivities at the Fort Worth Convention Center and Dickies Arena. The tournament will be a week-long, fishing-themed party with the world championship of bass fishing as its centerpiece. Only the fourth time the Classic has been held in the Lone Star State, it will get a Texas-sized boost in attendance and participation with an expected economic impact of more than \$25 million for local businesses. Weigh-ins this fantastic venue during the time when the Classic is and all of the usual festivities will be held in Fort Worth, traditionally held."

The Bass Pro Shops Bassmaster Classic, will return the state's 12th-largest city, with competition being held

on Lake Ray Roberts in nearby Sanger.

Fort Worth and Lake Ray Roberts hosted the event in 2021, drawing 147,197 fans. At the time, it was the second-largest crowd ever for a Bassmaster Classic and still a record for a Classic held in Texas.

This new Ladder Truck is a fire truck provides five key firefighting tools in one vehicle: a water pump, water tank, fire hose, aerial device, and ground ladders; making it a versatile multi-purpose unit for fire departments.
