Classic: The science of Ray Roberts

Will we see Toyota ShareLunkers cross the Classic weigh-in scales?

Trophy bass hunters from around the nation flock to Texas during springtime to catch a personal best largemouth, and the myriad entries into the Toyota ShareLunker program prove why. Joining them in that quest will be the 56 qualifiers in the Bass Pro Shops Bassmaster Classic presented by Under Armour.

The Classic will be played out March 21-23 on Lake Ray Roberts, with the chances of ShareLunker entries being weighed in a great possibility. The categories for ShareLunker entries are for largemouth weighing 8, 10 and 13 pounds and over. Legacy ShareLunkers weighing 13-plus pounds and caught during the January to March spawning season can be loaned to Texas Parks and Wildlife to support its selective breeding program, which stocks genetically superior offspring into Texas impoundments.

Will ShareLunker trophies come across the Classic stage? We turned to an expert to from Texas

Parks and Wildlife to find out.

“Ray Roberts sets up really well in March for catching big bass, with the bass moving into shallower water to spawn,” said Dan Bennett, district supervisor who oversees fisheries management on the Classic fishery. “Generally, when we get higher water, it provides more cover and habitat for bass as they get pushed into the button bush shorelines.”

Ray Roberts has produced six Legacy class ShareLunkers, including the current lake record weighing 15.18 pounds, coincidentally caught in March 2015. Since the Classic was last held in 2021 on Ray Roberts, three ShareLunker entries weighing over 10 pounds were caught in the month of March.

Prior to the impoundment of Ray Roberts in 1987, Texas Parks and Wildlife fisheries biologists envisioned following the same blueprint as Lake Fork, the state’s top producer of ShareLunker

entries. At both projects, Florida largemouth breeding pairs were stocked in existing farm ponds before the lakes were inundated. The theory was the trophy potential would be jump-started as the lake filled. At Lake Fork, the plan was an overwhelming success.

Texas Parks and Wildlife and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service coordinated a timber management plan during the construction process of Ray Roberts to boost sport fishing productivity. Approximately 3,000 acres of standing timber were left in the reservoir, while cleared timber was consolidated into 44 large piles, most located in the open water of the lower end.

What remains is roughly 2,000 acres of standing timber. Coverage area was reduced after the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers discovered significant erosion along the 2-mile riprap shoreline of the dam. The water level was lowered 12 feet to bolster the riprap, and in doing so, much of the newly

exposed and waterlogged standing timber collapsed at the water level.

The predominant visual habitat at Ray Roberts is the standing timber. Aquatic vegetation is sparse. The Elm Fork arm is more turbid than the west arm, due to runoff from farmland. Hydrilla grows in one cove on the east arm, and common and American pondweed covers about 10% of the surface area. Coverage of aquatic vegetation, namely milfoil and pondweed, expanded in 2023 to almost 7,000 of the lake’s 26,000 surface acres.

“Aquatic vegetation has increased somewhat since the last Classic in 2021,” said Bennett. “That’s due to natural causes with the stability of the lake level and rainfall supporting vegetation growth.”

Ray Roberts is divided into two arms that run north and south on the compass dial. Those are the Elm Fork of the Trinity River, to the west, and the east arm. The clearer



east arm supports the most aquatic vegetation, while the west arm tends to be more turbid due to the flow of the river.

As a Corps of Engineers Lake, there has been minimal development around the 259 miles of shoreline, so most of the shoreline is natural and consists of rocky banks and seasonally flooded shrubs like button bush.

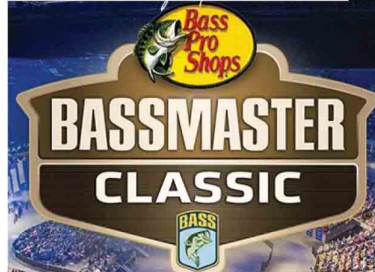
Ray Roberts is on a regular stocking program to keep the fishery up to par with other trophy lakes in Texas. The lake has received 4.6 million

Florida largemouth, with the fisheries management plan calling for subsequent stockings every two to three years. Notably in 2024, 347,000 Lone-star Bass were stocked, which are descendants of ShareLunker Legacy class largemouth weighing 13 pounds or more.

Will the Classic fishery show out with a double-digit trophy? There is a legit chance it will happen. After all, Texas is known as the land of the giants.

Bassmaster Classic coming back to Ray Roberts Lake: March 21-23, 2025



The Bass Pro Shops Bassmaster Classic, will return to Fort Worth for fishing’s biggest event of the year. Dubbed the Super Bowl of Bass Fishing, this tournament is estimated to draw crowds approaching 150,000 to Fort Worth as anglers compete for a \$1 million dollar purse on March 21-23, 2025.

Anglers will launch their boats at Isle Du Boise State Park just east of Sanger at Ray Roberts Lake. Weigh-ins will be held at Dickies Arena.

The Fort Worth Sports Commission will host the tournament and festivities at the Fort Worth Convention Center and Dickies Arena. The tournament will be a week-long, fishing-themed party with the world championship of bass fishing as its centerpiece. Only the fourth time the Classic has been held in the Lone Star State, it will get a Texas-sized boost in attendance and participation with an expected economic impact of more than \$25 million for local businesses. Weigh-ins and all of the usual festivities will be held in Fort Worth,

the state’s 12th-largest city, with competition being held on Lake Ray Roberts in nearby Sanger.

Fort Worth and Lake Ray Roberts hosted the event in 2021, drawing 147,197 fans. At the time, it was the second-largest crowd ever for a Bassmaster Classic and still a record for a Classic held in Texas.

“There was a lot of uncertainty in the world in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic the last time we visited Fort Worth — so much so that we had to move it to June instead of holding it in March,” said B.A.S.S. CEO Chase Anderson. “But the city of Fort Worth was so great to work with and the people in Texas came out and still made it one of the most exciting Classics we’ve ever had. They treated the Classic like what it is — a true celebration of the sport — even though circumstances forced that move to the summertime.

“Now, we’re really looking forward to going back to this fantastic venue during the time when the Classic is traditionally held.”

The Bassmaster Classic has announced an expanded FOX television coverage for the Bassmaster Classic at Ray Roberts Lake.



The annual Bassmaster Classic Outdoors Expo at the Fort Worth Convention Center will offer attendees deals on the latest fishing tackle and outdoors accessories from more than 200 exhibitors. They’ll also be able to rub shoulders with legends of the sport like Bassmaster and television superstar Bill Dance.

After soaking in all the Expo has to offer, attendees can enjoy the daily weigh-ins at nearby Dickies Arena, where a new angler will be crowned the Classic champion on Sunday, March 23, 2025. This title provides life-long clout and a \$300,000 first-place prize.

Sunny's Thoughts



In December, nearing the close of the holiday season I was somewhat busy “thinking” about holidays and what they indicated in the old US of A. Well, though I did write several hundred words my brain decided I needed an though hiatus and off it went hopping from subject to subject, with non seeming to take much form and substance as far as the written word was concerned. But, recently, my social experiences gave me pause for thought, so here goes. Sanger, though really no longer able to claim that it is a small town still exhibits some of the positive found in small towns. I saw this positivity demonstrated by both, recently. What I saw demonstrated was individuals and businesses who were contributing toward making Sanger a better place, a place where people were concerned about people. Now there are more examples than I am going to use in my “thoughts” today because Sanger is very blessed. However, my words will reflect my experiences of a limited time frame (unless, of course, my brain and my fingers run amuck LOL).

Recently, (i.e. February 21 and 22, to be specific) two local organizations stepped up and “did for Sanger.” They, each in their own way, gave back to their community. Bolivar Masonic Lodge and the Sanger Education Foundation each stepped forward and prepared to make difference.

Bolivar Masonic Lodge has been active for at least 150 years and is a well known service organization having many of the political, religious and social leaders as active members. They are one of those organizations that quietly participate in and help to shape a community. On one hand the members can be seen in our local parades like Homecoming and the annual Christmas Parade. They are the organization that throws out bags of popcorn which the children love. One of their service projects each year is to award to one or more graduating Senior from Sanger High School a scholarship. These hard-working, devout and dedicated men have other projects that support Sanger and its citizens. They support these projects with fund raisers. Recently, they held their fund raiser, the annual Chili Cook-off. Participants make their best chili, bring it to be judged and then sell the chili at an all you can eat event. Chili varies from what could be termed five alarm to the less inflammatory. Not only do you get delicious chili and the fixings there is also a table full of dessert choices. The money they raise goes directly back Sanger through their various projects. The Chili Cook-Off is only one of their fund raisers, all of which are done for others.

My other example from this past weekend is the Sanger Education Foundation. Founded more than 20 years ago it is a fine example of people working to help others. Those who provided the founding donations are listed, front and back, on the tablet found in front of the Sanger ISD Administration Building. The primary fundraiser for this organization is their annual Gala. My daughter and I had the privilege of attending this year's event. Not only is the evening entertaining with food and fellowship, it provides a time where major funds are generated. At this point you might be thinking well, so they raise money,

they give scholarships that is good for those graduating who qualify and apply. But, the Sanger Education Foundations does more than manage scholarships which have been started by families and groups as memorials. There are many of that type but the Foundations goes beyond just scholarships. There are three that I will mention here: The Fred H. Yeatts Memorial, the Sunny Yeatts Theatre Arts, and the Karen Hamilton Gunn Memorial. Each was put into place to assist students and department areas. The Fred H. Yeatts Memorial an endowed fund, is used to help our vocational programs (now know as CTE instead of vocational) by being there to assist our CTE students in preparing for a career by helping those who need help, pay for the certification exams they must take. This is only one use of this fund. The Sunny Yeatts Theater Arts Fund, on its way to endowment, is in placer to assist the Theatre Arts/ Fine Arts Department with equipment and materials the department needs to function at a helpful level for the students. The Karen Hamilton Gunn Fund (endowed) does somewhat the same for the Veterinary portion of the Agriculture Department. Three funds each of which provide the needs of students in those extremely varied subject areas. The Fred H. Yeatts and the Sunny Yeatts was founded by families, the Karen Hamilton Gunn was founded by her classmates. Donations help keep these funds available and useful as do the various Memorial and Honorary Scholarships (of which there are many).

The Foundation manages them all as well as raising funds to help Sanger students and faculty. The funds buy necessary equipment, supplies and materials. Funds are also used to provide teacher training and other assistance to instructors. This Gala provides a solid fund raising base which enables the SEF to support our schools. Strong schools help build and maintain strong communities. The Gala has silent and live auctions and you see the businesses and members of

the community both providing the materials to be auctioned and participating in the auctions themselves. As members of the community of Sanger we should be doing business with those businesses who have contributed. We should be totally aware of all of cared enough to donate their time, energy and skills to make the foundation a success. There are various committees available which need volunteers. I have not mentioned any names here for fear of leaving someone very deserving of mention out of my list. I'm sure Sanger News will give a complete report of participants. (The complete list of all contributors and donors will be published in the coming weeks).

These are just two examples of what can be termed as Service to Community. But the title doesn't come close to showing the positive effect that it has on our town. When you see people doing things for people. They are giving their time, their talents, their energy and they are making a difference. I've only mentioned the Masonic Lodge and the Sanger Education Foundation but there are many others here in our town.

I would like to close with this thought that each and every organization is made up of individuals and it is individual people who get things done. If you don't have the time, donate money, if you don't have the money donate your time/talents/knowledge/skills. Community is important BUT it is made up of individuals. The next time you are disappointed or disgruntled volunteer to help and see the difference you can make.
